

Training for PhD Students and Young Researchers – Developing skills for the future career

A project organised by the Slovak Academic Information Agency – SAIA, n.o., Bratislava in collaboration with the Austrian Federal Ministry of Education, Science and Culture, Vienna
The project is supported by the EUROPEAN REGIONAL DEVELOPMENT FUND INTERREG III

Target groups: PhD students and young researchers from Bratislava and Vienna regions (applicants must be under 35 years of age)

What is required:

1. Curriculum Vitae (English only)
2. employer's approval
3. good command of English language and active participation in the training cycle

Project objectives:

Development and improvement of skills of the selected group of PhD students and young researchers from Bratislava and Vienna regions in writing project proposals and in responding to opportunities for collaboration of the regions when drafting national, bilateral, and multilateral research projects.

- Development of skills for effective communication and decision-making in preparation and management of collaborative projects and management of work in research institutes.
- Fostering regional collaboration in the field of research when submitting national, bilateral and multilateral project proposals (bringing researchers together and enhancing their communication skills).

Brief Description of the Project:

The training sessions will focus on:

- **Writing project proposals taking account of the possibilities of collaboration of the regions and EU funded programmes, particularly the 7th framework programme (one-day training);**
- **Development of skills for future career and entering the labour market – facilitating team-work and understanding management of work in research institutes (two-day training).**

This training cycle includes 1 one-day and 1 two-day training for 10 Austrian participants, who are chosen by bm:bwk considering qualification.

All trainings will take place in Bratislava, communication language: English

Travel expenses will be reimbursed, accommodation and food provided

The next training sessions for Austrian participants will be held:

April 19, 2007 and May 23-24, 2007 (attending both dates is compulsory)

Deadline for applicants from Austria is March 9, 2007
