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ETHIKPLATTFORM

The Ethics Platform – founded in 2011 – is the motor and driving force for the systematic, participatory and constructive discussion of ethical issues at BOKU. The aim is to sensitize and generate awareness for the mutual understanding of responsible living at the University. This involves good mutual interaction within the whole BOKU community, with teaching and research being done against the backdrop of BOKU's social responsibility as a "University of Life".

The Ethics Platform

- ▶ further develops the basic ethical principles at BOKU,
- ▶ informs about and discusses basic ethical questions as well as BOKU-related topics,
- ▶ promotes the strengthening of ethical awareness in teaching,
- ▶ supports applicants with any ethical questions arising in their research proposals, upon request,
- ▶ initiates and coordinates research projects on ethics-related topics,
- ▶ forms networks with comparable initiatives at other Research Institutions for an exchange of ideas,
- ▶ cooperates with the UNESCO Bioethics Chair Vienna.

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ETHICS CHARTER

The Ethics Charter lays the foundation for acting responsibly at BOKU. It aims to generate awareness within BOKU and to communicate – internally and externally – that BOKU and its members attach great importance to acting in an ethically considerate manner.

The Ethics Charter is the consensual product of a thorough bottom-up consultation process involving the entire University. The basic ethical principles, operating values and objectives compiled in the five chapters of the Ethics Charter provide an ethical foundation and supplement the existing guidelines of BOKU. The objectives are formulated for cooperation within the BOKU community, including teaching and research.
