Responsibilities

- Study of the grapevine response to draught using semi-controlled field experiments in combination with greenhouse experiments
- Detailed characterization of the grapevine ecophysiology response to different degrees of draught stress (e.g. gas exchange, water potential, chlorophyll fluorescence)
- Study of the physiological traits linked to the response to drought (leaf traits, petiole/stem xylem anatomy)
- Study of the water use efficiency of grapevines by weighting lysimeters
- Sampling and analyses of vine tissues (leaves, berries) for metabolites analyses in HPLC and HPIC

Required skills and qualifications

- Master degree in Viticulture, Agriculture, Plant Sciences, Food Sciences, or related fields
- Previous experience working with grapevines
- Excellent knowledge of English
- Social- and teamwork skills
