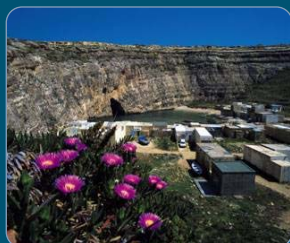

The total budget available for the 2007-2013 period is approximately EUR 780 billion (at 2004 prices). The instrument for Pre-Accession Assistance (IPA) consists of five modules: institutional development, cross border cooperation, regional development, human resources development and rural development. European Neighbourhood and Partnership Instrument (ENPI) provides grants for local development projects that target sustainable development and approximation to EU policies and standards in neighbour countries

Structural Funds and the Cohesion Fund:

Structural Funds are the European Union's main instruments for supporting social and economic restructuring across the Union. ERDF covers all areas: transport, communication technologies, energy, the environment, research and innovation, social infrastructure, and others. The Cohesion Fund finances projects designed to improve the environment and develop transport infrastructure in Member States whose per capita GNP is 80% below of the Community average.
