The tasks are integrated in the ACRP Project "Soil erosion in Austria – from mean to extreme (EROS-A)". The candidate should work within the project and do a doctoral degree at the University of Natural Resources and Life Sciences Vienna. The project will be conducted in close cooperation with the Federal Agency for Water Management (Petzenkirchen) and international cooperation partners.

For the subproject at BOKU the following specific tasks have to be fulfilled by the PhD-student:

- Statistical analyses of Austrian raingauges
- Calculation of soil erosion rates using numerical simulation models
- Development of a new approach to estimated daily erosion rates
- Publication of results in scientific journals
- Presentation of results at conferences
- Writing a doctoral thesis is desired
