The College of Natural Resources, Royal University of Bhutan offers internship for Master's students in organic agriculture / Natural Resource Management.

The College of Natural Resources with its Organic Programme under development needs support in diverse activities. Internship will support the Dean in the following fields:

- Analysis of relevant literature for developing research in organic farming
- Support in developing research toward organic farming
- Contribute to the development of the organic demonstration and research farm
