Fellows will stay in residence at the university where they are enrolled, and collaborate remotely as well as participate in trainings and at monthly All Fellow Meetings that are held in different European cities. To meaningfully participate in the Exergeia ground sweep for promising alternative energy technologies, a passion for science and invention applicable in the real world is key. Successful applicants will have both the desire to contribute their life energy to issues that matter, and the scientific literacy and operational capacity to add value. - Strong research and writing skills in English; other languages a plus;
- Ability to work in a task-driven way when properly guided and a pent for accuracy and attention to detail required, paired with the willingness to operate as a team player where necessary;
- Ability to organize and present findings;
- Proven track record of meeting project responsibilities an advantage;
- Knowledge of and adherence to professional ethics; and
- Curiosity, courage and perseverance.
