we from the Institute of Waste Management of the University of Natural Resources and Life Sciences are part of the project “Roadmap for used beverage cans”. The project deals with the question, where beverage cans waste ends up. The project focuses on the countries **Slovenia, Serbia, Greece, Bulgaria and Czech Republic**. Statistics from the countries show that there are many cans getting lost between purchase and disposal in regular bins.
