The EPICUR Forum opens for three virtual days and connects the academic community in six European countries: Erasmus Feeling Challenge, Keynote speeches of high-ranking experts addressing “Entrepreneurship and sustainable development”, live panel discussions, a virtual fair about the future of teaching and much more.

KIT hosts the event and offers a platform for students, researchers, administrative staff as well as local and regional stakeholders to discuss solutions to one of the most urgent questions: How can we develop Europe in a sustainable fashion and what role do companies have?
