EPICUR is looking for internships in the research area for BA and MA students at the University of Natural Resources and Life Sciences, Vienna and its seven excellent European partner universities. As part of the EU- and BMBWF/OeAD-funded innovative educational project "European Universities", multilingual students from different departments from all EPICUR universities are to be given the opportunity to complete 3 to 6-month research internships in Austria.

The internship positions can be allocated for the period June 2021 to October 2021.

Requirements for research institutes

- Ideally, your institution should be interdisciplinary and open to students from many fields of study.
- The topics of the research projects should be related to sustainability, mobility, migration and identity or public health.
- Your institution has experience with international students. It is important that the interns are accompanied by mentors. (Mentoring).
- Your institution is interested and is open to intercultural diversity.
- Ideally, the interns can be provided with financial appreciation in the form of pocket money.
- The internship should last at least 3 months and a maximum of 6 months.
- Due to the current COVID-19 situation, there is also the possibility of a hybrid internship, which consists of on-site presence and teleworking.

EPICUR sees itself as an educational project with a focus on excellence through inclusion and diversity. For us, this also includes multilingualism. Due to the internationality of our students, French, Polish, Greek and Dutch are the popular languages alongside German and English.

We therefore particularly invite research institutions with similar interests and internationality to apply!
