

1. Grants for students who study abroad in one of the programme countries

The programme countries are classified into three country groups according to the European Commission's Programme Guide, for which the following grant levels have been set in Austria:

| Categories of countries | Monthly grant in Euros |

| Group 1: Countries with a higher cost of living Belgium, Denmark, Finland, France, Germany, Ireland, Iceland, Italy, Liechtenstein, Luxembourg, Netherlands, Norway, Sweden | 670 |
| Group 2: Countries with a medium cost of living Estonia, Greece, Latvia, Malta, Portugal, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Czech Republic, Cyprus | 620 |
| Group 3: Countries with a lower cost of living Bulgaria, Croatia, Lithuania, North Macedonia, Poland, Romania, Serbia, Turkey, Hungary | 620 |

2. Top-ups for students with fewer opportunities

Students with fewer opportunities receive an additional monthly top-up of € 250.

This group includes:

- Students with children in need of care who are taken to the place of study.
- Students with disabilities.
- Students with a **chronic illness**, if this results in increased financial expenditure during the stay abroad (compared to the stay in the sending country).

3. Travel allowance

- for all types of mobility
- amount varies depending on the distance and means of transportation

| Travel distance | Green travel | Non-Green travel |

| 100 - 499 km | 285 EUR | 211 EUR |
| 500 - 1999 km | 417 EUR | 309 EUR |

| 3000 - 3999 km | 785 EUR | 580 EUR |
| 4000 - 7999 km | 1188 EUR | 1188 EUR |
| 8000 km or more | 1735 EUR | 1735 EUR |
