### 1. Grants for students who study abroad in one of the programme countries

The programme countries are classified into three country groups according to the European Commission's Programme Guide, for which the following grant levels have been set in Austria:

Categories of countries	Monthly grant in Euros
<b>Group 1: Countries with a higher cost of living</b> Belgium, Denmark, Finland, France, Germany, Ireland, Iceland, Italy, Liechtenstein, Luxembourg, Netherlands, Norway, Sweden	520
<b>Group 2: Countries with a medium cost of living</b> Estonia, Greece, Latvia, Malta, Portugal, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Czech Republic, Cyprus	470
<b>Group 3: Countries with a lower cost of living</b> Bulgaria, Croatia, Lithuania, North Macedonia, Poland, Romania, Serbia, Turkey, Hungary	470

### 2. Top-ups for students with fewer opportunities

Students with fewer opportunities receive an **additional monthly top-up of € 250**.

This group includes:

- Students with children in need of care who are taken to the place of study.
- Students with disabilities.
- Students with a chronic illness, if this results in increased financial expenditure during the stay abroad (compared to the stay in the sending country).

### 3. Travel allowance

- for all types of mobility
- amount varies depending on the distance and means of transportation
