



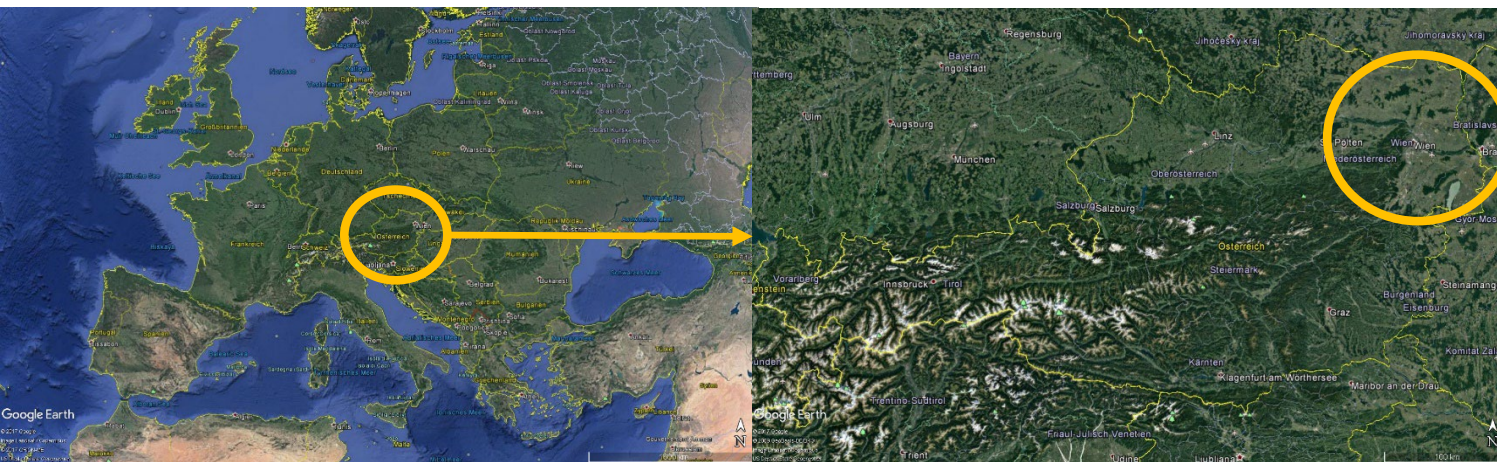

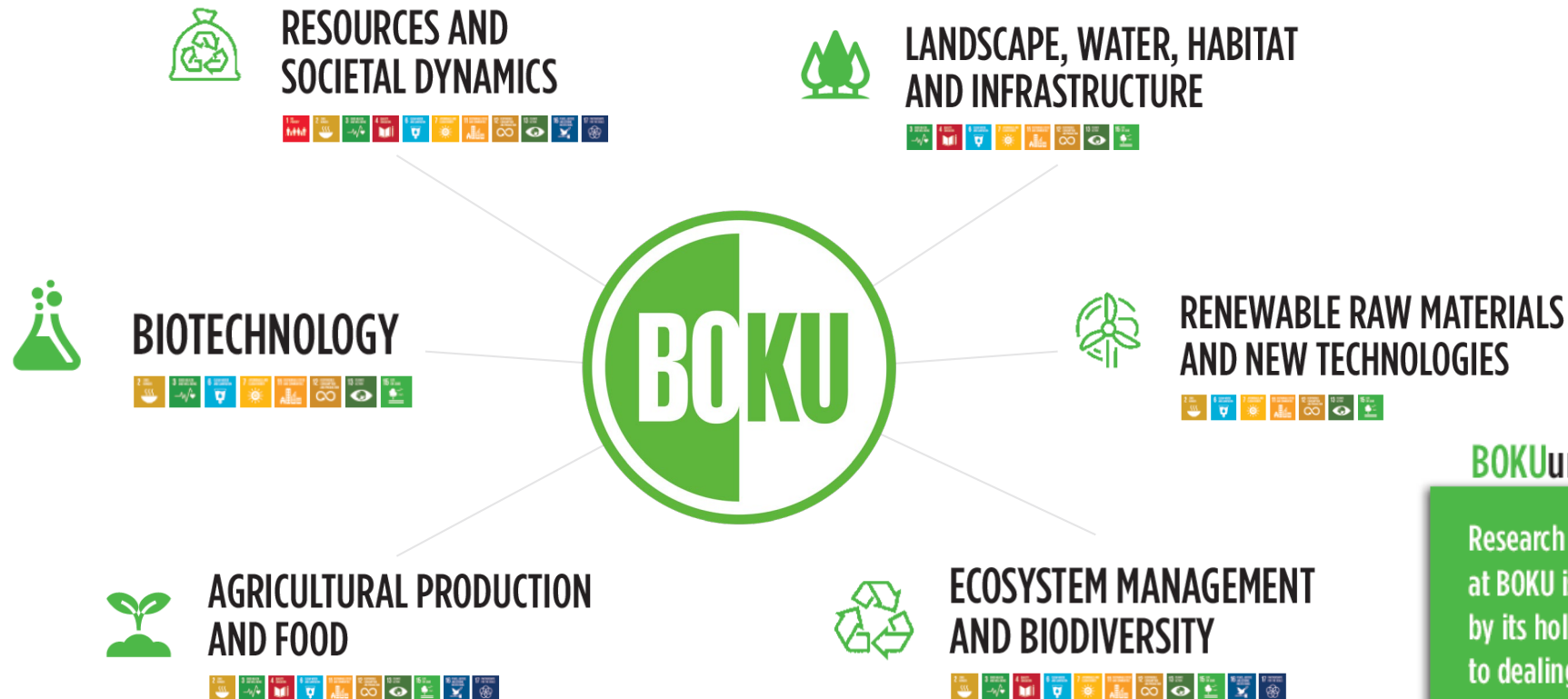

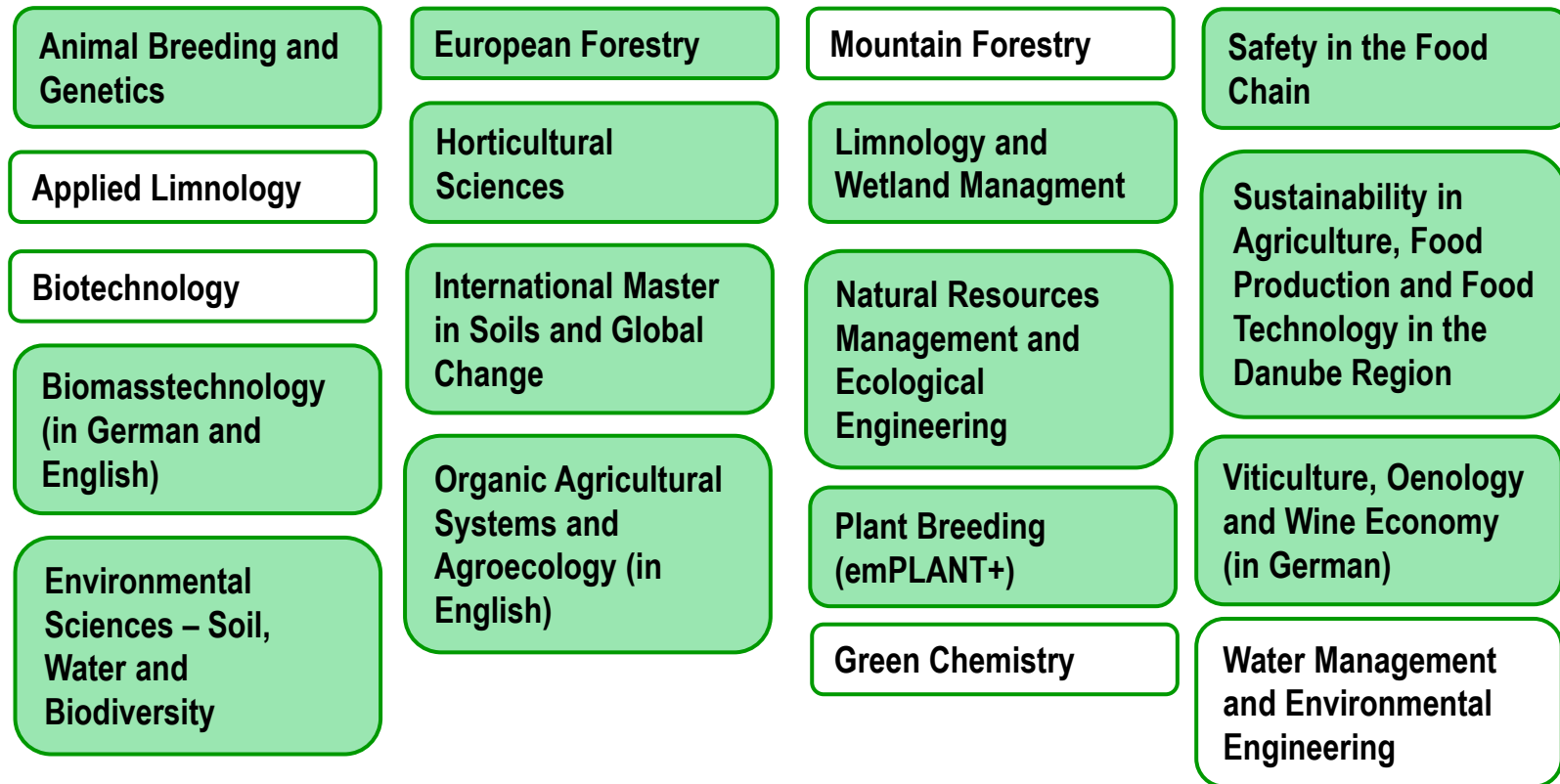

Accommodation & Visa

- University does NOT supply accommodation. Your options are:
 - Student dormitories (e.g. OeAD housing)
 - Flat share and Youth hostels → FB Accommodation Exchange BOKU
- Visa & Entry Permits
 - Non-applicable for students from EU/EEA member states or Switzerland
 - Non-EU/EEA/Switzerland (apply at embassy/consular service in home country)
 - Up to 6 months → Visa D
 - More than 6 months → Residence Permit 'Student'

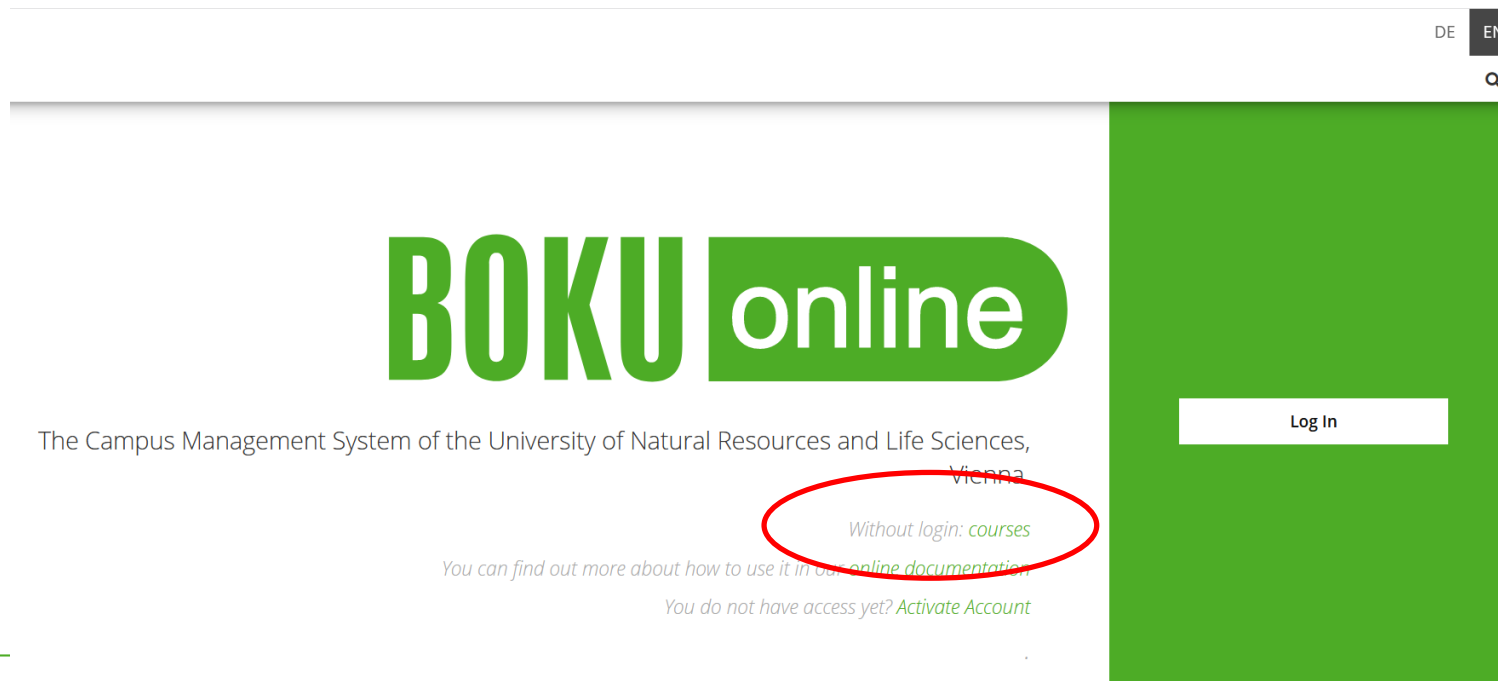

Content	Basics and elements of statistics; probability theory; concepts of hypothesis testing; concepts of parameter estimation; statistical models; estimation of fixed and random effects; nonparametric methods; design of experiments in the area of livestock science; Solving practical examples with the computer programmes Excel (data recording) and SAS (statistical analysis).
Previous knowledge expected	Statistics (Bachelor course equivalent to Statistics in Agricultural Sciences)
Objective	In the theoretical part, basic knowledge regarding (co)variance analysis, regression analysis and simple non-parametric methods is gained. Students develop understanding of theory by applying it on

Erasmus+ at BOKU

- BOKU has apr. 250 Erasmus Partner Universities in Europe
- Check first with your **home university** if BOKU is a partner in your field of studies
- Do application for **Erasmus scholarship** at your home university (check deadlines), get nominated at BOKU by your home university
- **Online application at BOKU:**
 - For summer semester: mid Sept. – **November 30**
 - For winter semester: mid April – **June 30**
 - For internships: all year round, before internship starts

CEEPUS at BOKU

- CEEPUS is a inter-university cooperation and mobility programme for students and lecturers. The following countries participate in the CEEPUS programme:
 - **Albania, Austria, Bulgaria, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Croatia, Czech, Kosovo, Hungary, North Macedonia, Moldavia, Montenegro, Poland, Rumania, Serbia, Slovakia.**
 - The student exchange is in the framework of university networks.

 - 15 June for applicants for the winter semester and academic year
 - 31 October for summer semester candidates
 - 30 November for Freemover

Joint Study at BOKU

- Joint Study agreements are **bilateral agreements between two universities** and respectively their faculties (colleges). In the agreements, the exchange of students for one semester is arranged. Tuition fees are released for the most part.
 - **USA, Australia, New Zealand, Peru, Mexico, Japan, Chile, South Africa**
- First, **application at your home university** for a nomination to BOKU. Please contact the International office or the International Programme Coordinator of your home university!
- When you are nominated you have to complete the application form of the University of Natural Resources and Life Sciences Vienna.
