- You will receive an acceptance letter from the Center for International Relations (ZIB). NOTE: You do NOT have to register in person by 5th February. This deadline does not apply to exchange students; it is possible to register up until the end of February.
 Complete the preliminary online registration <a href="http://www.boku.ac.at/en/zid/themen/teach-learn/studium-meldung-nth-meldun
- weitermeldung-abschluss/voranmeldung/ and note the number (Note: Upload a picture and fill in your nationality otherwise you will be asked to fill in an Austrian social security number). The deadline of 5th February does NOT apply to exchange students.
 - Make sure you arrive in Vienna a few days BEFORE the semester starts in order to deal with administrative issues and register for courses.

Immediately after arrival:

- ☐ Get your **BOKUcard (= student ID) and PIN code for BOKUonline** at the Study Services (= Studienservices)

- You have to pay the student union fee of € 20,20 by bank card (Maestro, Visa, Master card). If you don't have a card that works in Austria, you can ask your Buddy to go with you to the study services and pay with his/her card. Important: If you pay online or with a payment form, you can only activate your BOKUonline account and register for courses approx. 5 days after the payment was made.
- □ Activate your BOKUcard

Go to the green terminals on the bottom floor by the vending machines (in the same building). Put your card in and the machine will print the validity date on it.

□ USTAT1 Form

After your registration at the study services you need to fill in the USTAT1 form in BOKUonline. For this you need the "Ersatzkennzahl" (alternative number) for the Austrian Social Security Number. You can find this "Ersatzkennzahl" in your "Studienblatt" (records of studies) that you can download in BOKUonline (-> enrolment documents, top right corner).

- □ Plan your **weekly course schedule** in BOKUonline **and register for all courses in BOKUonline**When and where are your courses? Do courses overlap? If yes, which courses can you take instead? (If necessary your learning agreement can be changed later) see "scheduled dates" in the course description in BOKUonline: http://online.boku.ac.at (see also http://online.boku.ac.at/en/zid/themen/teach-learn/bokuonline-erste-schritte-fuer-studierende/
 - ► Register as soon as possible some courses (excursions, seminars, practical courses...) will book up quickly.
