





Exchange student at BOKU

- Via Erasmus+, CEEPUS, Joint Study,...
- Spend 1-2 Semesters at BOKU
- You can choose from the entire course offer at BOKU
- Apply first at your home university for Erasmus+ grant
- Online application at BOKU (+ learning agreement)
 - At Bachelor level: German skills level B2
 - At Master level: English or German skills level B2

Accomodation & Visa

- University does **NOT supply accomodation** but provide information. Your options are:
 - Student dormitories (e.g. OeAD housing)
 - Flat share and Youth hostels → FB Accommodation Exchange BOKU
- Visa & Entry Permits
 - Non-applicable for students from EU/EEA member states or Switzerland
 - Non-EU/EEA/Switzerland (apply at embassy/consulary service in home country)
 - Up to 6 months → Visa D
 - More than 6 months






Course search in BOKUonline

Living Costs

• Accommodation €300 to €600/month

• Food €400 to €500/month

• Other expenses €300 to €400/month

• Registration fee (student union fee) €24,70/semester

• Tuition fees (non EU-citizens) €726,72/semester *

• Public transportation €75 – 150/semester

• In total approx. €1000 to €1500/month

*Students coming on exchange to BOKU are exempt from tuition fees
