

What to do first? – Checklist for trainees at BOKU

Welcome to BOKU!

Be	fore arrival:				
	You received the acceptance letter sent by the BOKU-International Relations (BOKU-IR) via Mobility-Online. You have to register personally at BOKU directly after your arrival.				
	Book an appointment online for the registration at the study services during the registration period (only after the physical registration you can enrol in courses): https://boku.ac.at/studienservices/terminbuchung-studienservices (select "Termin Evidenz"; booking is recommended 10-14 days in advance)				
	Complete the preliminary online registration https://short.boku.ac.at/it-pre-registration + remember the number (Attention: Please upload your picture and fill in your nationality – otherwise you are asked to fill in an Austrian social security number). The deadline on 5 th September does NOT apply for exchange students.				
Ma	ke sure you arrive in Vienna 1-2 days BEFORE your traineeship starts to deal with administrative issues !				
lmi	 Mediately after arrival: At the appointment date (see above): Get your BOKUcard (= student ID) and PIN code for BOKUonline at the study services (= Studienservices): Gregor Mendel Haus, 2nd floor, Gregor Mendel Str.33, 1180 Wien. (Attention: only after booking an appointment – see above). Make sure you bring your: passport or ID admission letter, with the number from the online registration bank card (maestro, visa, master card,) to pay the student union fee of € 25,20 If you don't have a card that works in Austria, you can ask your Buddy to go with you to the study services and pay with his/her card Important: If you pay online or with a payment form, you can only activate your BOKUonline account and register for courses approx. 5 days after the payment was made. 				
	Activate your BOKUcard Go to the green terminals on the ground floor by the vending machines (in the same building). Put your card in and the machine will print the validity date on it.				
	Mark in Mobility-Online that you have received and activated your BOKUcard.				
	☐ Activate BOKUonline account https://short.boku.ac.at/6gyr48 → Use the PIN that you received at Study Services (Studienservices).

	Register in Vienna (by Austrian law you have to register within the first 3 days of your stay) at the municipal district offices (locations and opening hours: https://www.wien.gv.at/english/living-working/registration/) • Make an appointment: https://www.wien.gv.at/werwaltung/meldeservice/pdf/meldezettel.pdf (inofficial engl translation see: https://short.boku.ac.at/int-in-vienna-registration-en.html) • Signature of landlord/dormitory • Bring your passport				
	Get your public transport semester ticket https://www.wienerlinien.at/web/wl-en/tickets-for-students You can buy the ticket online (€ 75 - only a few days after your registration at BOKU) and print it out yourself, or go to any Wiener Linien ticket office (€ 78) • Bring your BOKU card and confirmation of study enrolment (Studienbestätigung, which you can download from BOKUonline)

ONLY for EU/EEA/Swiss	citizens who intend t	o stay in Austria for	longer than 4 months:

Get the "Anmeldebescheinigung" (EU/EEA/Swiss citizens who plan to stay longer than 3 months – application at the latest 4 months after registration in Vienna – additional costs) at the MA 35 – Arndtstraße 65-67, Stiege 1, first floor, 1120 Vienna. Or MA 35 Karmelitergasse 9, first floor, 1020 Wien (depending on district of residence). Office hours and appointment booking:

☐ Bring your:

- passport/ID, registration confirmation (= Bestätigung der Meldung) and your proof of admission (e.g. BOKUcard)
- bank statement or scholarship confirmation or affidavit of support from parents or spouse
- proof of health insurance (e.g. European Health Insurance Card)

☐ Students from countries without E-card and from countries without specific agreements: Health insurance (€ 73, 48 per month) at Österreichische Gesundheitskasse ÖGK:

Bring your BOKUCard

☐ ÖH-cafeteria sticker "Mensapickerl" (discount for the cafeterias)

→ Fill out the ,Mensapickerl' form at the ÖH Secretariat (Österreichische HochschülerInnenschaft = student union). An ,M' will be printed on your card.

→ Register your bankcard with your BOKUcard at the cashier on your first visit to the cafeteria.
