- ✓ Maintain the momentum of the Water Innovation FA promoting investment of innovative solutions
- ✓ Putting water in the center of a systemic approach for ecoinnovation and circular economy
- Help unlock public and private investments in the water sector
- ✓ Make wider use various Horizon 2020 financial instruments and create opportunities for synergies with other EU funds (Cohesion funds, LIFE+, etc.)
