## **EPICUR Seed Funding 2025: Application phase open!**

EPICUR is once again supporting interdisciplinary research projects through the EPICUR Seed Funding Scheme 2025, with the aim of intensifying research collaboration and future joint teaching and learning between members of the alliance. Projects will be funded with up to €150,000 each. The proposal must include the design and planning of a joint EPICUR learning activity of a minimum of 6 hours to be implemented during the seed funding phase (or in the six months following the end of the project).
