 - Forestry value chain (coordinated by SK)
 - Sustainable yields and agro-ecological intensification (HU)
 - Bioenergy and new value-added products (HR)
 - Food Systems (PL)
 - Fresh water based bioeconomy (CZ)
 - Education and Skills (CZ)
